



Invocation & Opening Dialogue

- M: In the name of the Father and of the + Son and of the Holy Spirit.
- C: Amen.
- M: I believe that God created me and all that exists, and that he gave me my body and soul, eyes, ears and all my members, my mind and all my abilities.
- C: By faith we understand that the universe was formed at God's command, so that what is seen was not made out of what was visible.
- M: God still preserves me by richly and daily providing clothing and shoes, food and drink, house and home, spouse and children, land, cattle, and all I own, and all I need to keep my body and life.
- C: The Lord makes grass grow for the cattle, and plants for people to cultivate—bringing forth food from the earth.
- M: I believe that Jesus Christ, true God, begotten of the Father from eternity, and also true man, born of the virgin Mary, is my Lord.
- C: When the set time had fully come, God sent his Son, born of a woman, born under the law, to redeem those under the law, that we might receive adoption to sonship.
- M: Christ has redeemed me, a lost and condemned creature, purchased and won me from all sins, from death and from the power of the devil, not with gold or silver, but with his holy, precious blood and with his innocent suffering and death.
- C: The Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many.
- M: I believe that I cannot by my own thinking or choosing believe in Jesus Christ, my Lord, or come to him. But the Holy Spirit has called me by the gospel, enlightened me with his gifts, sanctified and kept me in the true faith.
- C: No one can enter the kingdom of God unless they are born of water and the Spirit. Flesh gives birth to flesh, but the Spirit gives birth to spirit.
- M: In the same way, the Holy Spirit calls, gathers, enlightens, and sanctifies the whole Christian Church on earth, and keeps it with Jesus Christ in the one true faith.
- C: There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called to one hope when you were called; one Lord, one faith, one baptism; one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all.
- M: Oh, the depth of the riches of the wisdom and knowledge of God! From him and through him and for him are all things.
- C: To him be the glory forever! Amen.

Numbers 6:22-27


²²The LORD said to Moses, ²³"Tell Aaron and his sons, 'This is how you are to bless the Israelites. Say to them:



Sermon Text

Numbers 6:22-27


Sermon

Please stand.

Confession of Faith: Athanasian Creed Part 1

- M: Whoever wishes to be saved must, above all else, hold the true Christian faith.
- C: Whoever does not keep this faith pure in all points will certainly perish eternally.
- M: Now this is the true Christian faith:
- C: We worship one God in three persons and three persons in one God, without mixing the persons or dividing the divine being.
- M: For each person—the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit—is distinct,
- C: but the deity of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit is one, equal in glory and coeternal in majesty.
- M: What the Father is, so is the Son, and so is the Holy Spirit. The Father is uncreated, the Son uncreated, the Holy Spirit uncreated; the Father is infinite, the Son infinite, the Holy Spirit infinite; the Father is eternal, the Son eternal, the Holy Spirit eternal;
- C: yet they are not three who are eternal, but there is one who is eternal, just as they are not three who are uncreated, nor three who are infinite, but there is one who is uncreated and one who is infinite.
- M: In the same way the Father is almighty, the Son is almighty, the Holy Spirit is almighty;
- C: yet they are not three who are almighty, but there is one who is almighty.
- M: So the Father is God, the Son is God, the Holy Spirit is God;
- C: yet they are not three Gods, but one God.
- M: So the Father is Lord, the Son is Lord, the Holy Spirit is Lord;
- C: yet they are not three Lords, but one Lord.
- M: For just as Christian truth compels us to confess each person individually to be God and Lord,
- C: so the true Christian faith forbids us to speak of three Gods or three Lords.
- M: The Father is neither made nor created nor begotten of anyone. The Son is neither made nor created, but is begotten of the Father alone. The Holy Spirit is neither made nor created nor begotten, but proceeds from the Father and the Son.
- C: So there is one Father, not three Fathers; one Son, not three Sons; one Holy Spirit, not three Holy Spirits.
- M: And within this Trinity none comes before or after; none is greater or inferior,
- C: but all three persons are coequal and coeternal,
- M: so that in every way, as stated before, all three persons are to be worshiped as one God and one God worshiped as three persons.
- C: Whoever wishes to be saved must have this conviction of the Trinity.

Prayer of the Church

- M: Triune God, you are the one eternal God, whose name we praise forever. We would not have known you if you had not revealed yourself to us as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, three persons, yet one God. Remove from us all doubt and grant us humble faith as we contemplate this high and holy mystery.
- C: Enlighten and empower us to worship you as the triune God, the holy Trinity.
- M: God our Father, whatever good is in us, whatever good things we have, and whatever good we do comes from you alone. In you we live and move and have our being.
- C: Open our eyes to see the gifts you provide every day purely out of your own love and care.
- M: Lord Jesus our Savior, you came into our world to make the Father known to us. You joined yourself to us by taking on our humanity and brought us back to God by shedding your blood. In love you walked the way of suffering and carried the wrath of God that we deserved because of our sins. Help us believe that all you did and all you endured you did to rescue us and set us free.
- C: In the bright new hope of your resurrection teach us to offer our lives in praise to God and love to our neighbor.
- M: Creator Spirit, you breathed into us new life by the power of the gospel, opened our eyes to see the light of your grace, and filled our minds with the clear sound of your voice. Through Word and sacrament lead us to understand more completely how broad and deep and high is the love of God in Christ Jesus. Firm up our resolve to do battle with Satan and sin.
- C: In every weakness be our strength, that we may show ourselves to be God's children: faithful in prayer, constant in hope, and fervent in love.
- M: Hear us, Lord, as we pray in silence. *Silent prayer*
- M: Holy Trinity, you are the God of glory, the God of grace, and the God of all comfort.
- C: We rejoice to call you Father, Son, and Holy Spirit and praise your holy name forever. Amen.

Lord's Prayer

C: Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come, your will be done on earth as in heaven. Give us today our daily bread. Forgive us our sins, as we forgive those who sin against us. Lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. For the kingdom, the power, and the glory are yours now and forever. Amen.




