

Trinity Tuition Policy – April 2008

Immanuel will pay a percentage of the tuition costs at Trinity Lutheran School in Jenera. Parents will be responsible for the remainder. The church's percentage will be determined each year after Immanuel's budget has been approved by the Voters.

If a member family is unable to pay their share of tuition, they may request assistance from Immanuel. The Elder liaison to the Education Board will be the representative to handle fund assistance. The Church Council will approve such requests. Members are asked to make these requests by April 1st, before the annual budget is approved.

Immanuel has a **Trinity Tuition Fund** in their budget that members can contribute to. Donations designated to this fund will help pay Immanuel's portion of tuition.

In 2007 a **Family Tuition Assistance Fund** was set up to allow members to contribute to help parents with their share of tuition. Funds available as of January 1 of the school year will be distributed to Trinity Lutheran School proportionately between all Immanuel students up to the maximum of the family's share of the tuition.

Each spring, a notice will be given to Immanuel's families encouraging them to send their children to Trinity Lutheran School. At that time, this policy will be explained. Members are asked to let the Council know by April 1st, if they plan on having children attending Trinity Lutheran School.
